

RESEARCH: 4,219 PASTORS FROM 18 DENOMINATIONS

The majority of pastors serve small churches (80% <200, 55% <100) with small budgets (50% <\$125K) and small salaries (50% <\$50K).

Many pastors/spouses are **suffering in silence** financially.
